Subject: Request for Single Source Selection consideration under the Public Procurement Act and Rules to the Center for Environmental and Geographic Information Services (CEGIS)- a Public Trust established by the Government of Bangladesh.

The undersigned is directed to inform him/her that the Center for Environmental and Geographic Information Services (CEGIS) is a Public Trust established by the Government of Bangladesh under the Ministry of Water Resources auspices. This national organization, CEGIS, was initiated to create local technical capabilities to assist efficient and effective use and manage natural resources.

2. **Board of Trustees (BoT), CEGIS:** A 15-member Board of Trustees (BoT) governs the CEGIS, chaired by the Secretary of the Ministry of Water Resources while the heads of the Bangladesh Water Development Board; the Water Resources Planning Agency; the Department of the Environment; the Department of Fisheries; the Department of Roads and Highways; the Local Government Engineering Department; the Department of Public Health Engineering; the Space Research and Remote Sensing Agency; the Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority; the **Rajdhani Unnayan Karttripakkha (RAJUK)** and a professor of the Department of Water Resources Engineering from the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET), a professor of the Department of Geography and Environment from the University of Dhaka, the IUCN's Bangladesh Country Representative and a government-nominated NGO representative, are the trustees.

3. **Multidisciplinary CEGIS:** CEGIS is a multidisciplinary organization that specializes in Fisheries; Economy; Agricultural science; Social science; Water science & Water resources planning; Civil engineering; Water resources strategic biology-environment; Climate change; Power, Energy, and Mineral Resources; River formation; Soil; Water, Air, and Sound quality; Geographical Information System (GIS); Remote sensing (R.S.); Database, Programming, Information technology, etc. CEGIS has a team of about 30 different professions and specialized subject domains. They also have state-of-the-art computer network and server systems, GIS, R.S., Climate Model Water Modeling software and equipment systems, and own websites.



০২। এ ক্ষেত্রে পিপিআর ২০০৮ বিধি-১০৪ (ঘ)(২)(ঈ) (সংশোধিত) এ উদাহরণ হিসেবে (BUET, BIDS, BPATC, BIM, BIAM, ESCB, IIFC ইত্যাদি) প্রতিষ্ঠানসমূহ এর উল্লেখ আছে মাত্র। অর্থাৎ বিধিতে উল্লেখকৃত প্রতিষ্ঠানসমূহের মধ্যেই তা সীমাবদ্ধ নয় বিধায় "ইত্যাদি" উল্লেখ আছে। নাম উল্লেখ থাকুক বা নাই থাকুক একক উৎস হিসাবে নির্বাচিত করার ক্ষেত্রে পিপিআর-২০০৮ এর ৪৮ বিধি অনুযায়ী প্রতিষ্ঠানকে যোগ্যতা নির্ধারণের সকল মানদণ্ডে উত্তীর্ণ হতে হবে। সুতরাং দরদাতার যোগ্যতা এবং একক উৎস হতে ক্রয়ের যৌক্তিকতা থাকলে সরকারি মালিকানাধীন বা বিশেষায়িত প্রতিষ্ঠান হিসাবে CEGIS বিধি-১০৪(ঘ)(২) (ঈ) এর আওতায় বুদ্ধিবৃত্তিক ও পেশাগত সেবা প্রদানকারী প্রতিষ্ঠান হিসেবে ক্রয়কারীর নিকট বিবেচিত হতে পারে।
